A good time was had by all, and now we look forward to the Christmas party!



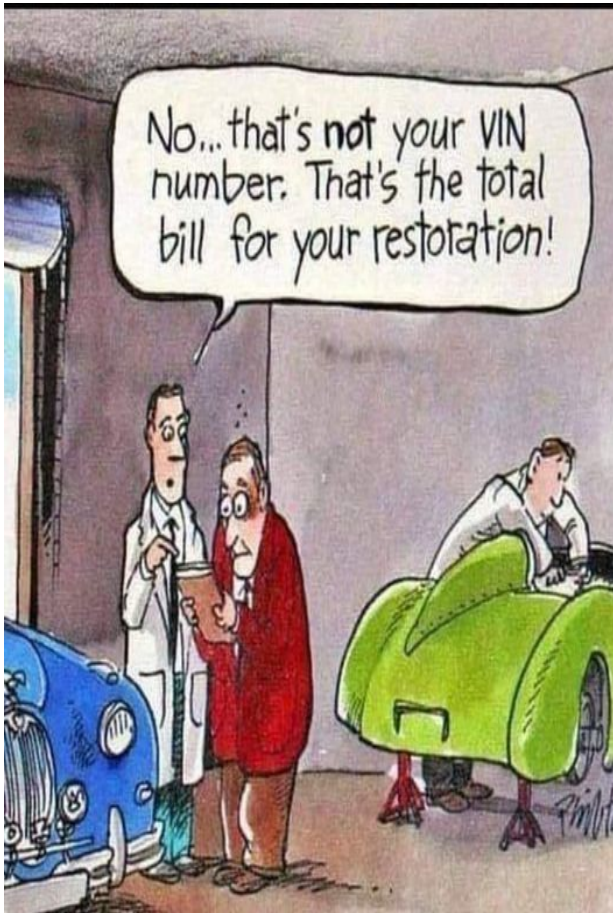


Renewal time for TRAACA and AACA



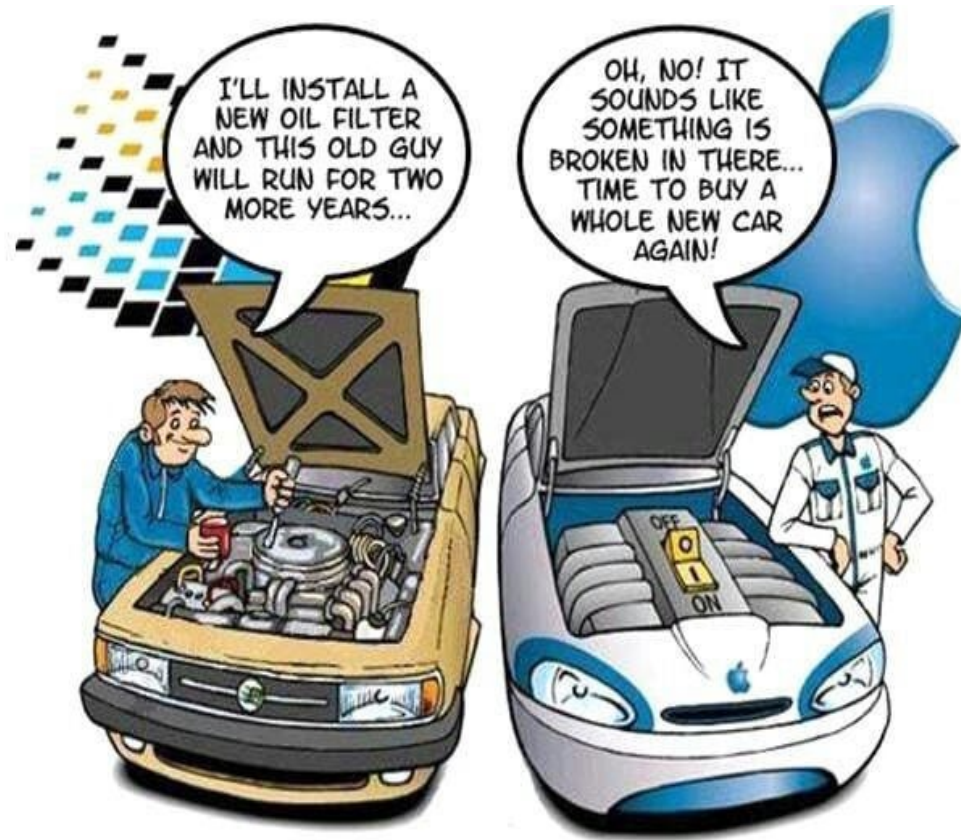
