Bus would be \$45 per person or if we have a great turnout, \$55.00 for


the 55 passenger bus.



We all send our best wishes to Shirley and hope she recovers quickly.




Craig McCollum attended the show in Pavo Georgia on Sept 11th. His Austin Healey won best in Class there! Congrats Craig!
