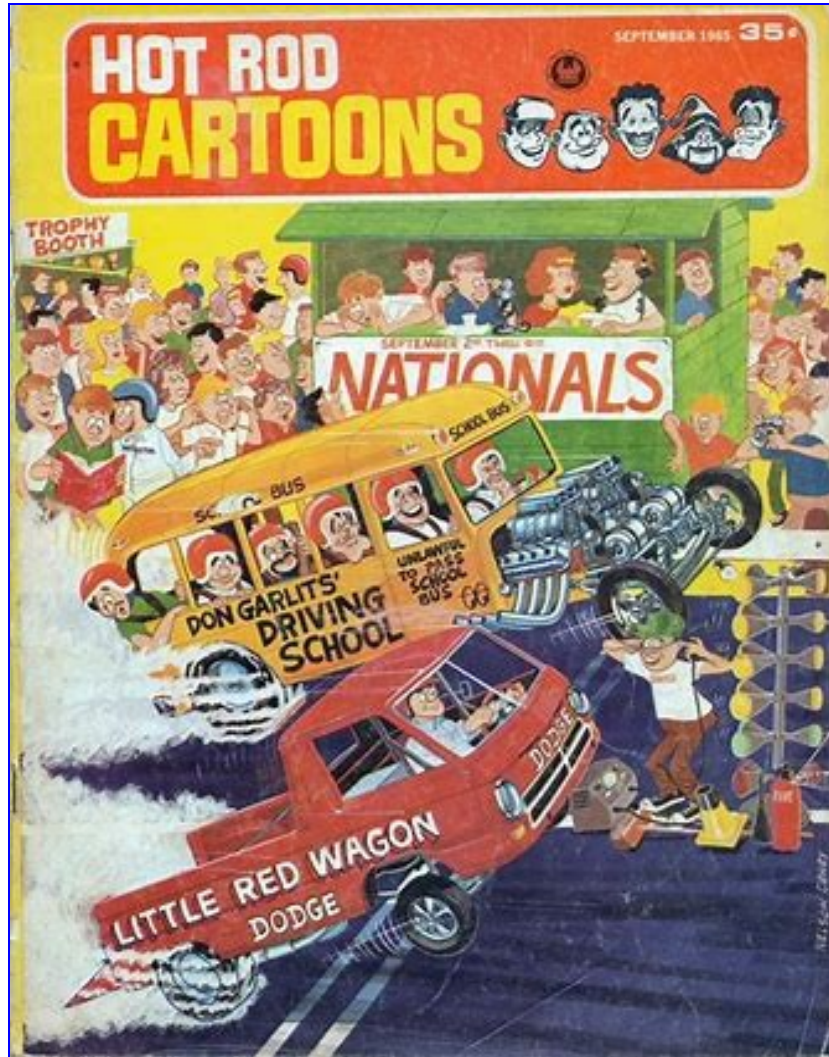




Hoping everyone had a safe 4th of July!

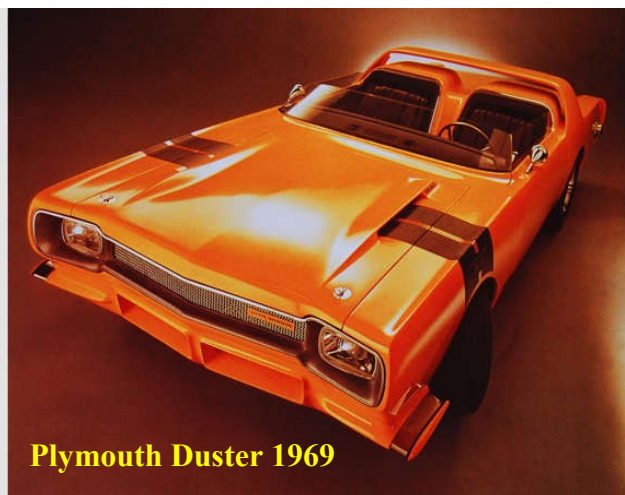

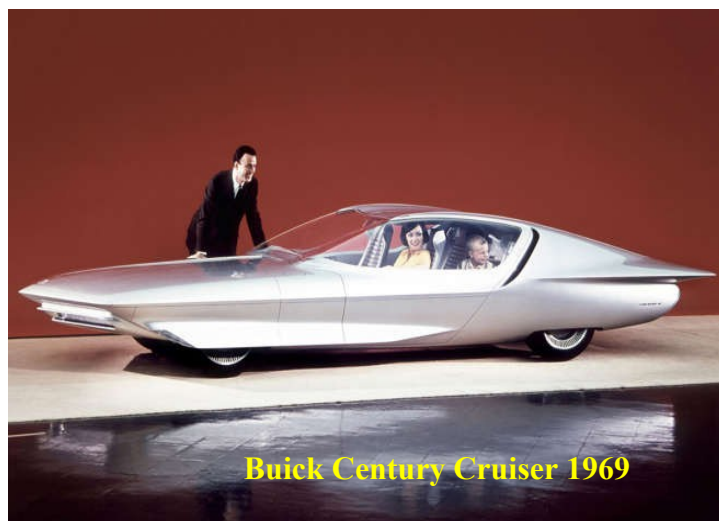

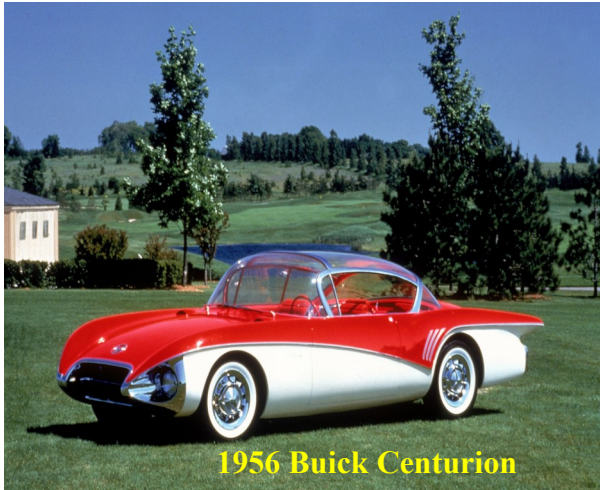
